

THE PERÚ CORNER

REPORTS FROM THE FRONTLINE

I greet you all in the precious name of Jesus. It has been several months since we first began our journey to the various villages for medical attention and spiritual encouragement. There have been some hurdles along the road but even in the midst of troubles and times of testing, I give God the glory and thanks for protecting us and moving the project forward.

Up to this point we have been able to visit over a dozen villages, see close to 400 people for medical attention, and preach the Word to countless others. I feel so honored and blessed to be a part of this humbling endeavor and to be working with so many wonderful brothers and sisters in Christ, both at the Peru Projects base and in the villages. As many of you

know, my cousin, who accompanied me on this trip to provide nursing support, became very ill at the end of March. He needed to be admitted to the Adventist Hospital in Iquitos, Peru for treatment. It took a week but he fully recovered. The tests were inconclusive to what exactly he had, but it appears it may have been an atypical form of Dengue fever. However, we both want to thank everyone for the continued prayers of good health and safe travels during our time here. We are now focusing on areas south of Pucallpa, Peru. I will plan on sharing encouraging stories of the medical work on our next encounter. Until then may the Lord continue to bless all of us and please keep us in your prayers. We wouldn't be able to do this without them.
